

LAND PLOTS

- The total area of land plots is 206 hectares.
- The land plots are located outside the city at a distance of 5 to 12 km from Kodyma.
- Ownership: communal
- Agricultural land.
- Distance to electricity and water supply networks - 1 km.
- Water disposal is autonomous, gas supply is absent.
- Access roads to most of the land plots are asphalted and partially dirt.
- Railway station passenger/freight
